Objectives

- 1. To develop an action plan containing suitable objectives and targets to minimise environmental impact.
- 2. To comply with relevant national legislation and codes of practice.
- 3. Constantly monitor and evaluate our consumption of resources there by reducing our pollution and energy consumption; endeavouring to re-use, recover or recycle materials where practicable.
- 4. To minimize water wastage by monitoring usage and installing equipment which conserves metered water and retains rainwater for grounds use.
- 5. To source wherever possible bio friendly chemicals in order to minimize our chemical impact on the environment.
- 6. To protect the natural environment and wildlife and enhance bio-diversity
- 7. To source locally produced food from suppliers who operate organic and animal welfare practices to achieve the best quality and minimum food miles.
- 8. To communicate the Environmental Policy to guests through electronic mediums and to encourage environmentally responsible behaviour.

- 10. Where practicable procure the highest energy rated appliances
- 11. To ensure that all employees are aware of the camp Environmental Policy and are encouraged to contribute improved environmental practices.
